1. Attendance:

2. Apologies:

3. Approval of minutes of meeting held on 1st March 2022 and 5th April:

Both were approved vote 3:0.

4. Public participation:

There were no issues raised.

5. Declarations of Interest:

There were no declarations of interest.

6. Highways:

a. Councillor Hellier informed the Council that the work on the Bridleway had not yet been completed and he would be in contact with the responsible officer at B&NES to progress this.

b. Councillor Ford raised the issue of the work which had recently been carried out with a resurfacing machine on the local lanes, the quality of the work was very poor, and it was agreed that this should be reported to B&NES.

ACTION: Clerk to raise with B&NES.

7. Planning applications

a. New applications:

i. 22/01542/FUL – Tanglewood Cottage, Nempnett Street: erection of western extensions, including alterations to roof and associated works. The application was considered by the council which concluded that it neither supported nor objected to it and did not wish to offer any comments.

b. Decisions:

i. 22/00156/FUL - Church Farm - the application had been withdrawn.

ii. 22/00157/FUL - Church Farm - the application had been withdrawn.

8. Finance:

a. The bank reconciliation for 9th March to 8th April 2022 was reviewed and approved, vote 4:0.

b. Payments for approval: The following payment was approved, vote 4:0 –

i. Avon Local Councils Association annual subscription - £66.36.

c. Bank account:

i. The Clerk reported that completion of the HSBC addition of signatories form had been delayed as the final signatory had not been available. Once this had been obtained and it would be submitted to the bank

 - i. The clerk confirmed that J Hayward had agreed to be the internal auditor and the accounts should be ready for presentation to the next council meeting.

 - a. There was no update on progress with the planning application appeal.
